The purpose of this Society is to promote interest in the study, preservation, and dissemination of the history of The United Methodist Church and its antecedent bodies.

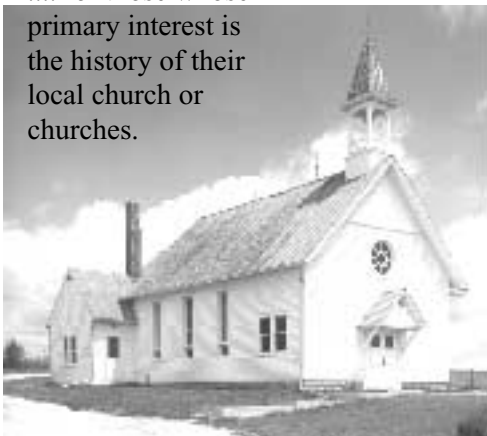


Come join with like-minded people who are archivists, family and church historians, educators, and others, both lay and clergy, to learn more about our shared history.
